



## 2008-2009 Estimated Graduate Cost of Attendance

The table below illustrates the estimated cost of attendance for the 2008-2009 academic year (August - May) for a graduate student enrolled for **9 hours** for fall and spring semesters. Cost of Attendance (COA) minus the expected family contribution (EFC) determines an applicant's financial need for financial aid.

- 3 **Room and board** for off-campus and commuter students is paid by the student directly to the landlord / property manager / family member. The figures given reflect average costs; individual experience will vary. On-campus amounts are based on weighted average of residence hall charges and Silver meal plan.
- 4 **The cost of books and supplies, transportation, and miscellaneous personal expenses** are set by "the marketplace" and are paid by the student directly to the seller/provider.
