



## 2009-2010 Estimated Cost of Attendance

The table below illustrates the estimated cost of attendance for the 2009-2010 academic year (August - May) for an undergraduate student enrolled for **15 hours** for fall and spring semesters. Cost of Attendance (COA) minus the expected family contribution (EFC) determines an applicant's financial need for financial aid.
